

Ar bhonn inbhuanaithe agus i gcomhar le príomhpháirtithe leasmhara, cáilíocht na beatha buanseasmhach agus níos fearr agus eacnamaíocht áitiúil láidir a bhaint amach i gCorcaigh trí chothromaíocht a aimsiú sa chaidreamh idir phobail, forbairt eacnamaíoch agus cáilíocht chomhshaoil.

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Réamhfhocal an Ardmhéara

Is mór an phribhléid agus an onóir dom gur toghadh mé i mo Ardmhéara ar Chathair Chorcaí agus is rud é a fhanfaidh liom ar feadh mo shaoil. Tá sé ina cuspóir agam i rith mo théarma oifige a bheith ag fónamh ar son mhuintir Chorcaí agus ar son na Cathrach féin. An fhís atá agam i leith Chorcaí ar feadh na bliana seo, tá sí bunaithe ar na luachanna a d'fhág i gcónaí gur cathair ar leith í Corcaigh, luachanna a cuireadh in iúl dom agus mé ag déanamh stocaireachta i gcomhair na dToghchán Áitiúil.

Creideann ár gcuid saoránach i gcothrom na féinne, i ndeiseanna agus sna freagrachtaí atá orainn i leith a chéile. Creideann siad i gCathair ina bhfuil poist ar fáil dóibh siúd ar mian leo tabhairt fúthu agus ina bhfuil ioncam réasúnta ina luach saothair ar an obair chrua, agus creideann siad nach mór borradh a bheith faoin ngnó agus rath a bheith ar theaghlaigh ionas go mbeidh an geilleagar stuama. Ní bheidh sé éasca féachaint chuige gur mar sin a bheidh cúrsaí san am atá le teacht. Beidh meon an chomhoibrithe de dhíth óna lán earnálacha agus iad ag obair le chéile chun díriú ar na dúshláin atá le sárú ag an gcathair.

Tá sé ina thosaíocht agam go mbeidh Corcaigh

- Ina Cathair Chultúir, agus í faoi bhláth.
- Ina Cathair bheoga, inbhuanaithe atá Slán Sábháilte.
- Níos Glaine agus Níos Glaise.
- Inrochtana, cuimsitheach agus go mbeidh meas ar na pobail éagsúla ar fad atá ina gcónaí laistigh de theorainn na cathrach.
- Ina cathair a mhúsclaíonn bród ina lucht cónaithe agus ina mbíonn rath ar chuairteoirí chuici.
- Ina cathair ina bhfuil poist fhiúntacha ag na saoránaigh, ina bhfuil áit chónaithe ag gach duine, agus ina n-éiríonn go geal leis na gnólachtaí.

Is iad na comhaltaí tofa a dhéanann ionadaíocht i gcónaí ar riachtanais agus tosaíochtaí a gcuid pobal, agus is iadsan fós a chuireann chun cinn an ceapadh beartais. Gabhaim buíochas leo as ucht na hoibre a dhéanann siad thar ceann a gcuid toghthóirí.

Cuirim fáilte roimh an gcinneadh ionad imeachtaí a fhorbairt do Chorcaigh ar an bPríomhshráid Theas. Infheistíocht straitéiseach is ea an fhorbairt sin agus is tionscadal an-spreagúil í a mbeidh an-tionchar aici ar an gcathair féin agus ar na gnólachtaí sa chathair. Creidim go mbeidh an t-ionad nua ina chúis le hathrú ó bhonn ar Chorcaigh agus go gcabhróidh sé leis an gcathair í féin a shamhlú as an nua.

Ní fhéadfaí a bheith i mbun an leibhéil seirbhísí a chuireann an Chomhairle ar fáil do mhuintir Chorcaí murach an tiomantas a thugann baill foirne ar fud na Comhairle ina leith. A bhuíochas le hobair foirne agus le solúbthacht níos mó ón bhfoireann, mar aon le héiteas láidir um sheirbhís phoiblí, rinneadh íoslaghdú ar thionchar na n-acmhainní a bheith laghdaithe.

Tá cáil orainn i bhfad i gcéin as an gcion atá againn ar ár gCathair agus ár gContae agus as a bhródúla atáimid astu. Deirimid uaireanta gurb í Corcaigh 'an phríomhchathair cheart' agus cé nach bhfuil ansin ach fonóid den chuid is mó, léirítear ann go measann a lán daoine gur cathair den scoth í Corcaigh. Go deimhin, is mór an meas a bhí ag a lán Ardmhéaraí romham ar an gcathair uasal a raibh siad ina bun, agus sin é an meas chéanna atá á léiriú agamsa le linn mo théarma oifige. Creidim go daingean nach mór dúinn ar fad a bheith ag obair le chéile chun fírinne a dhéanamh d'fhís níos nuaí, níos fearr do chathair seo na reibiliúnach agus a cuid saoránach.

Réamhfhocail an Phríomhfheidhmeannaigh

Is iomaí dúshlán atá le sárú ag an gComhairle Cathrach. Bhí tionchar ag roinnt blianta den déine agus ag na dúshláin maidir le cúrsaí airgeadais na tíre ar an gComhairle Cathrach. Tá a lán dár bhfoinsí ioncaim faoi bhrú go fóill, agus tá méadú tagtha ar an éileamh ar chuid mhór dár seirbhísí. É sin ráite, shilféa go bhfuil rian éigin le sonrú anois de “Phéacáin Ghlasa an téarnaimh” a bhfuil trácht orthu le fada an lá.

Tá an obair tosaíthe ar an gceap oifigí nua ag 1 Cé Ailbhe. Beidh áit do 2,000 oibrí san fhorbraíocht nua 9 stór sin, a chosnóidh €50m. Tá an tionscadal seo ar cheann de na hinfheistíochtaí aonair is mó ón earnáil phríobháideach sa chathair le blianta beaga anuas, agus go deimhin beidh sé ar cheann de na forbraíochtaí oifige is mó i lár na cathrach le blianta fada.

Cuirfidh forbairt an chip oifigí borradh ollmhór faoin gcathair agus faoi athnuachan cheantar na ndugaí, agus is comhartha soiléir í gur áit ghnó tharraingteach í an chathair. Cuideoidh an fhorbraíocht seo le hathbheochan na cathrach agus cuirfidh sé borradh a bhfuil géarghá leis faoin ngeilleagar, trí chruthú thart ar 300 post le linn na céime tógála. D’fhógair Tyco, an chuideachta ilnáisiúnta shlándála agus chosanta ar dhóiteáin, go gcruthóidh siad 500 post in ionad seirbhísí nua agus tá sé deimhnithe acu gurb in 1 Cé Ailbhe a bheidh an t-ionad sin lonnaithe. Tá cinneadh Tyco an t-ionad a lonnú i lár na cathrach ina dhearbhu creidimh maidir le todhchaí ár gcathrach iontaí.

Gar do dheireadh mhí na Nollag, rinneadh cinneadh faoi ionad imeachtaí a bhfuiltear ag súil leis sa chathair le fada. Beidh an t-ionad lonnaithe áit a mbíodh an chuideachta Beamish and Crawford ar an bPríomhshráid Theas. Óstálfar réimse imeachtaí lena n-áirítear ceoldrámaí, ceolchoirmeacha, coinbhinsiúin agus comhdhálacha, taispeántais, seónna srl. san ionad nua, ina mbeidh áit do lucht féachana 6,000 duine. De bharr forbairt an ionaid imeachtaí, cuirfear borradh a bhfuil géarghá leis faoin ngeilleagar áitiúil, agus

beidh mórbhuntaistí geilleagracha i gceist don réigiún, go háirithe in earnáil na turasóireachta agus earnáil an fháilteachais, agus ar ndóigh, beidh an t-ionad nua ina chatalaíoch maidir le forbairt gheilleagrach mhórchéantar na cathrach.

Cuireadh feabhas arís eile in 2014 ar ról na Comhairle maidir leis an bhforbairt gheilleagrach a chur chun cinn nuair a cuireadh Oifig Fiontair Áitiúil (OFA) Chorcaí faoi chúram Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí. Beidh na hoifigí fiontair áitiúla amuigh chun tosaigh maidir le forás gnó agus poist a sholáthar, agus beidh tacaíocht dhíreach ar fáil uathu agus é ina chuspóir fáil réidh le go leor de na gnáthchonstaicí a bhíonn le sárú ag gnólaigh beaga, amhail scileanna bainistíochta, rochtain ar airgeadas agus margaíocht. Cuirim fáilte freisin roimh bhunú Choiste Forbartha Pobail Áitiúil Chathair Chorcaí i mbliana agus táim ag tnúth le bheith ag obair leo ar forbairt an Phlean Gheilleagraigh agus Pobail Áitiúil a bheidh ina threoir maidir le gníomhaíocht gheilleagrach agus gníomhaíocht phobail sa chathair ar feadh na sé bliana atá romhainn.

Mar fhocal scoir, ba mhaith liom mo bhuíochas a ghabháil leis an Ardmhéara agus le comhaltaí tofa Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí as an tacaíocht a thug siad dom le linn na bliana. Is mian liom freisin buíochas a ghabháil leis an bhfoireann as a gcuid tacaíochta agus as an obair chrua a dhéanann siad, as a ndúthracht agus as a dtiomantas do sheirbhísí ardchaighdeán a chothabháil agus a chur ar fáil. Tá mé cinnte go mbeidh toradh ag an gCathair ar obair chrua agus tiomantas dá leithéid in 2015, mar a bhí go dtí seo.

Chief Executive's Foreword

The City Council faces many challenges. Several years of austerity and challenges in the national finances have impacted on the City Council. Many of our income sources continue to be under pressure, while demand for many of our services has increased. However the long spoken of "Green Shoots of recovery" seem finally to be taking hold.

Work has commenced on the new office block at 1 Albert Quay. This 9 storey, €50m development will have capacity for 2,000 workers. This project is one of the single largest private sector investments in the city over the past number of years, and indeed will be one of the largest office developments in the city centre in decades.

The development of this office block is a massive boost for the city and the regeneration of the docklands, and provides a clear sign that the city is an attractive place to do business. This development will help revitalise the city and provide a much needed economic boost from the creation of approximately 300 jobs during the construction phase. Tyco, the multinational fire protection and security company announced that they will create 500 jobs at a new services centre and have confirmed 1 Albert Quay as their base for this centre. The decision by Tyco to locate in the city centre is a strong statement of faith in the future of our wonderful city.

In late December, a decision was made on the long awaited events centre for the city. The centre will be located at the former Beamish and Crawford site on South Main Street. The 6,000 capacity venue will host a range of events including musicals, concerts, conventions/conferences, exhibitions, shows etc. The development of the events centre will provide the local economy with a much needed boost, and will reap major economic benefits for the region, especially in the tourism and hospitality sectors, and of course act as a catalyst in the wider city's economic development.

The role of the Council in promoting economic development was further enhanced in 2014 with the Cork Local Enterprise Office (LEO) coming under the remit of Cork City Council. LEO's will be the front line in delivering business growth and jobs, providing direct support, with the aim to overcome many of the typical barriers to success that are faced by small businesses such as management skills, access to finance and marketing.

I also welcome the establishment of the Cork City Local Community Development Committee this year and I look forward to working with them in the development of the Local Economic and Community Plan which will inform and guide economic and community activity in the city for the next six years.

In conclusion, I would like to thank the Lord Mayor and the elected members of Cork City Council for their support during the year. I also wish to thank staff for their support and hard work, dedication and commitment to maintaining and providing quality services. I am sure that such hard work and commitment will continue to reap rewards for the city in 2015.



Athshlánú an Ghleanna, Céim 2

Cuireadh Céim 2 de thionscadal athnuachana an Ghleanna i gCathair Chorcaí i gcrích i mí an Mheithimh 2014.

Tógadh an scéim sin san áit a mbíodh seacht mbloc árasán ó thús na 1970í a raibh an iompraíocht fhrithshóisialta tar éis dul i gcion orthu.

Leagadh na bloic árasán chun áit a dhéanamh do scéim nua ina mbeadh 58 dteaghais nua agus ionad seirbhísí pobail saintógtha ina bhfuil an grúpa Fo-rochtana Óige, Foróige, Tionscadal Comharsanachta don Óige agus grúpa litearthachta ABLES do dhaoine fásta.



Is éard a bhí i gceist leis an straitéis ná leas a bhaint as tithe cúl le cúl chun sráid chónaithe a chruthú feadh Ascaill an Ghleanna, agus rinneadh dhá chlós iata nua thart timpeall ar na tithe atá ann cheana féin ar Bhealach Ard Éireann agus i bPáirc an Chomaraigh áit a mbíodh spás oscailte nach raibh dea-shainithe.

Rinneadh cabhsáin nua do na tithe a bhí ann cheana féin, mar aon le ballaí teorann ionas go mbeidís ag teacht leis na tithe nua.

Tá an foirgneamh seirbhísí pobail leabaithe sa scéim chun leas a bhaint as maoirseacht éighníomhach ó na tithe thart timpeall air, ach tá sé oscailte ar an ingearchló thiar, trína gcruthaítear an tríú clós, ceann níos lú atá ag dul leis an séipéal.

Is tithe 3 sheomra leapa, ceaptha do chúigear, atá sa scéim den chuid is mó, mar aon le meascán d'aonaid bheaga lena n-áirítear árasáin dhá urlár.

The Glen Regeneration Phase 2

Phase 2 of the regeneration of the Glen in Cork City was completed in June 2014.

The scheme was built on the site of seven flat blocks dating from the early 1970's that had fallen victim to anti-social behaviour.

The flat blocks were demolished to make way for a new scheme consisting of 58 new dwellings and a purpose-built community services centre housing the Youthreach, Foroige, Neighbourhood Youth Project and ABLES adult literacy groups.



The strategy consisted of using back-to-back housing to create a residential street along Glen Avenue, and two new enclosed courtyards formed around the existing houses in Arderin way and Comeragh Park where there had previously been poorly defined open space. The existing houses were given new driveways and boundary walls to tie in with the new housing.

The community services building is embedded into the scheme to take advantage of passive supervision from the surrounding houses, but opens up on the west elevation, creating a third, smaller courtyard in tandem with the church.

The dwellings for the most part are 3 bedroom, 5 person houses, with a mix of smaller units including duplex units.

Bóthar na Cille Móire

Cuimsítear sa scéim seo tógáil fiche a trí aonad inlíoanta agus athfheistiú beag ar dhá aonad atá ann cheana féin. Tá idir aonaid phríobháideacha agus aonaid shóisialta trí stór agus dhá stór i gceist leis na tithe, agus iad socraithe feadh dhá shráid a bhfuil crainn ag fás lena dtaobh. Tá an togra bunaithe ar an gcoincheap atá sa Mháistirphlean ón nGníomhaireacht Foirgníochta Náisiúnta (NBA) agus ar phrionsabail dearaidh uirbigh maidir le scála agus mórdhlúthú na sráideanna, trína mbíonn teaghaisí trí stór os comhair na bpríomhbhealaí dailte cónaithe – sa chás seo, Bóthar na Cille Móire Íochtarach, agus na teaghaisí dhá stór os comhair sráid chónaithe, Ardán Chill Iníon Léinín sa chás seo.

Tá achar thart ar 73m x 70m sa suíomh (1.31 acra) agus tá titim níos mó ná sé mhéadar aduaidh ann. Tá fána ghéar anuas go dtí an suíomh atá ina shuí go daingean i dtopagrafaíocht reatha an cheantair, agus tá na haonaid níos ísle ag breathnú ó dheas agus radharc iontach ar fud na cathrach le fáil uathu. Tá an tionscadal ar an gcéad chéim de na hoibreacha athnuachana a rinneadh mar chuid de Scéim Athnuachana Iarthuaisceart na Cathrach agus is í Rannóg Ailtire na Cathrach a dhear agus a bhainistigh an tionscadal. Tá tógáil an tionscadail seo, a chosnóidh €4 mhilliún, ar bun ar an suíomh faoi láthair. Cuireadh tús leis na hoibreacha i Meitheamh na bliana 2014 agus tá siad le bheith críochnaithe i mí Dheireadh Fómhair 2015.

Séadchomhartha Náisiúnta – Deisiú agus Athchóiriú

Cúlra an tSéadchomhartha Náisiúnta a dhear DJ Coakley (I gCuimhne Fhir 1798, 1803, 1848, 1867)

Tá an Séadchomhartha Náisiúnta, a dhear an t-ailtire D.J. Coakley, ar an taobh theas de Shráid an Chapail Bhúí i gCathair Chorcaí. Leagadh síos an bhunchloch

Each dwelling has its own entrance and private defensible space to the front. Where space was restricted, in order to avoid the private open space to the rear of dwellings backing onto public open space, the private open space has been incorporated into the units in the form of roof terraces, taking advantage of the surrounding views.

Kilmore Road

This scheme comprises of the construction of twenty three infill units and a small amount of refurbishment to two existing units. The houses are a mix of private and social three storey and two storey units and arranged along two tree lined streets. The proposal follows from the National Building Agency (NBA) Masterplan concept and from urban design principles of scale and massing of streets, whereby three storey dwellings front onto the main residential distributary routes – in this case Kilmore Road Lower and the two storey dwellings front onto a residential street, in this case Killiney Heights.

The site measures 73m x 70m, approximately, (1.31 acres) and has a fall of over six metres running north to south. Steeping down to sit firmly into the existing topography of the area, the lower units face south with a spectacular aspect across the city. This project is the first phase of regeneration works done as part of the City Northwest Regeneration Scheme and was designed and project managed by the City Architect's Department. Construction of this 4 million euro project is currently on site. Works began in June of 2014 and are due to be completed in October of 2015.

National Monument – Repair and Restoration

Background on the National Monument DJ Coakley (Memorial to Men of 1798, 1803, 1848, 1867)

The National Monument, designed by architect D.J. Coakley, stands at the south end of Cork City's Grand Parade. Its foundation stone was laid as part of the centenary celebrations of the 1798 rebellion, on the spot previously occupied by a statue of George II, though the Monument was not completed until 1906. As well as being one of the city's best known landmarks, it is of

Tá cúig dhealbh ag cur barr feabhais ar an séadchomhartha, agus iad cóirithe d'aolchloch Chill Chainnigh. Laistigh de na príomh-áirsí tá Éire an Mháthair, ar mó ná duine í, agus ag gach ceann de na ceithre choirnéal, ar bhonn ard, tá fíor lena léirítear an ghluaiseacht ar son neamhspleáchas na hÉireann: Wolfe Tone, Peter O'Neill Crowley, Michael Dwyer, agus Tomás Dáibhís.

Oibreacha Glantacháin agus Athchóirithe

D'fhostaigh an Chomhairle Cathrach sainchaomhnóir dealbh i rith an tsamhraidh chun an Séadchomhartha a ghlanadh agus a athshlánú, ar chostas iomlán €68,000. Is é an caomhnóir cloiche Eoghan Dalton a rinne an obair, faoi mhaoirseacht Neil Purkiss, Rannóg na nAiltirí agus Niamh Twomey, Oifigeach Oidhreacht Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí.

great historical and emotional significance nationwide. It commemorates the rebellions of 1798, 1803, 1848 and 1867 and stands as a lasting memorial to the memory of the patriots whose names are incised into six stone panels around its perimeter.

Neo-Gothic in style, the 48ft high, canopied monument is mostly composed of Cork limestone and features a number of mini-columns cut from Connemara marble (green) and Middleton red marble. The exclusive use of 'native' stones in its construction was almost certainly intentional, given the nationalist sentiment behind its erection. The Monument is enhanced by five statues, hewn from Kilkenny limestone. Enclosed within the principal arches is a larger than life-size Mother Erin, while at each of the four corners, on a high pedestal, stands a figure representing the movement for national independence: Wolfe Tone, Peter O'Neill Crowley, Michael Dwyer, and Thomas Davis.

Cleaning & Restoration Works

A sculpture conservation specialist was engaged over the summer by the City Council to clean and restore the Monument at a total cost of €68,000. The work was carried out by stone conservator Eoghan Dalton under the supervision of Neil Purkiss, Architects Department and Niamh Twomey Heritage Officer Cork City Council.

- Removal of cement pointing, repointing with the lime mortar.
- Raking out and repointing with lime mortar where original lime mortar has lost integrity.



The Cork City and County Archives preserves one of Cork's largest and most important cultural heritage assets. It is a powerful finding aid for those undertaking historical and genealogical research, and a valuable addition to the Council's online services.

The Catalogue contains detailed information on the contents, structure and background of the records and documents held, with extensive information and indexes of persons, families, places, institutions, events, time periods, and subjects. The culmination of 10 years of work by archivists and support staff, it is a major step forward in making Cork's archives publicly accessible, as required by the Local Government Act of 2001.



Bhí leabharlann nua, lena ndéanfar freastal ar phobal beagnach 13,000 duine i gceantar Chnoc an Chuilinn agus Chnoc na hAoine, móide an chuid thiar de Gharrán na mBráthar/Páirc na hEaglaise agus ar Thobar Rí an Domhnaigh, á tógáil i rith na bliana 2014.

Is é an gnólacht ó Chorcaigh CUMNOR Ltd an príomhchonraitheoir le haghaidh an tionscadail. Cuireadh tús leis an obair ar an láthair i mí na Nollag 2013, agus faoi dheireadh na bliana 2014 bhí cruth imlíneach na leabharlainne nua le feiceáil go soiléir.

- Programmes such as the 'It Seems History is to Blame' programme focusing on the events of 1913-1923 and the lessons we can learn, the Cork World Book Fest each April, Heritage Week, and Children's Book Fest annual programmes.
- The numerous other special and recurring events serving citizens of all ages, and
- The excellence of online services on the City Libraries' two websites, www.corkpastandpresent.ie and www.corkcitylibraries.ie.

Building for the future: new libraries new Hollyhill Library.

A new library, to serve a population of close on 13,000 in Hollyhill / Knocknaheeny area, plus the western part of Gurranaebraher / Churchfield, and Sunday's Well, was under construction during 2014.

Cork firm CUMNOR Ltd. are the main contractors for the project. Work began on site in December 2013, and by the end of 2014 the outline shape of the new library was clearly to be seen.

The total cost of the project is ca €4.1 million for this state of the art library building of 876 M², with €400,000 of that being spent on new stock for the Library.

Is maith mar a d'fhreastail an foirgneamh atá ann faoi láthair ar an bpobal le níos mó ná tríocha bliain anuas, ach glacann an pobal agus an Chomhairle Cathrach araon leis nach bhfuil an foirgneamh oiriúnach a thuilleadh don fheidhm atá aige.

Maidir leis an bhfoirgneamh atá ann faoi láthair,

- Níl áit ann don ghnáthstoc, do na bailiúcháin speisialta, ná do na spásanna staidéir agus na spásanna eile a mbíonn gá leo i leabharlann sa 21ú haois;
- Ní féidir leis freastal ar riachtanais an phobail ó thaobh TFC, sainseirbhísí, taispeántais, cainteanna, ceardlanna agus gníomhaíochtaí eile, srl.;
- Tá sé an-lag ó thaobh creatlaí, le díon atá ag ligean agus cumhdach seachtrach scagach;
- Tá sé thar a bheith mí-éifeachtach ó thaobh úsáid fuinnimh, agus is foirgneamh neamh-inbhuanaithe é ar a lán cúiseanna;
- Ní chomhlíonann sé na caighdeáin inrochtaineachta do dhaoine faoi mhíchumas.

Hollyhill Library will be a pro-active agent of social, educational, and cultural inclusion, and will have;

- A total stock of 36,700 items – books, DVDs, CDs, for children, teens and adults.
- A community-use multi-purpose room, and facilities for lifelong learning and literacy.
- PCs for internet and e-learning.
- Exhibition space for local and travelling exhibitions.

A new City Library

Cork City Council proposes to develop a new CITY LIBRARY on Grand Parade. The existing building has served the public well for more than three decades, but it is accepted by both the public and the City Council that the building is no longer fit for purpose.

The existing building

- Cannot accommodate the stock resources, specially-focused collections, and the study and other spaces required in a 21st century library.

In 2014, cuireadh i gcrích cúig aonad nua de bhuanchóiríocht neamhspleách a ndearnadh cistiú orthu faoin Scéim Cúnaimh Chaipitil, agus rinneadh cistiú ar ocht n-aonad cóiríochta faoin Áis um Iasacht Caipitil i gcomhair Leasúcháin (CALF). Sna haonaid sin, cuireadh cóiríocht fhadtéarmach ardchaighdeán ar fáil do dhaoine sa tseirbhís do dhaoine gan dídean. De bharr na haonaid sin a bheith ar fáil, cruthaíodh folúntais do dhaoine eile chun bogadh ó chóiríocht éigeandála isteach i gcóiríocht idirthréimhseach áit is féidir na scileanna a thabhairt dóibh ionas go mbeidh ar a gcumas bogadh ar aghaidh go dtí áit chónaithe neamhspleách fhadtéarmach. Faoin ngairm tograí in 2014, ceadaíodh Seirbhísí an Aoire Mhaith i leith cistithe chun uasghrádú agus athchóiriú a dhéanamh ar Áras Edel agus ceadaíodh cistiú do Chlann Shíomóin Chorcaí chun 12 aonad cóiríochta eile a chur ar fáil.

Faoin bprótacal um chistiú díláraithe maidir le leithdháileadh cistithe faoi Alt 10 le haghaidh daoine gan dídean, leithdháileadh buiséad €4,272,197.00 do Réigiún an Iardheiscirt agus €3,480,298.00 do Chomhairle Cathrach Chorcaí. Chuir gach Údarás Áitiúil sa Réigiún ar a laghad 10% den leithdháileadh foriomlán ar fáil as a chuid acmhainní féin i dtreo seirbhísí do dhaoine gan dídean.

Tógáil Tithe

In 2014, fuair Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí Leithdháileadh Caipitil €1.793m i gcomhair Tógáil Tithe, ón Roinn Comhshaoil, Pobail agus Rialtais Áitiúil. Cuidíonn an leithdháileadh sin le cur i gcrích 3 chinn de Scéimeanna inlíonta ina gcuirfear ar fáil 6 aonad cóiríochta, agus táthar á úsáid freisin chun cistiú a dhéanamh ar na cuntais chríochnaitheacha ar scéimeanna a críochnaíodh ag Na Cluainte, Cnoc an Chuilinn, Tannery Gardens, Siúlán na Lobhar agus Susie's Field, An Gleann Trasna, An Gleann. Rinneadh leithdháileadh breise €1.537m ag deireadh na bliana 2014 chun cistiú a dhéanamh ar cheannach 8 n-aonad inacmhainne gan díol don soláthar tithíochta sóisialta.

Homeless Service

In 2014, five new units of permanent independent accommodation which were funded under the Capital Assistance Scheme were completed and eight units of accommodation were funded under Capital Advance Leasing Facility (CALF). These units provided good quality, long term accommodation for people in homeless service. These units, in turn created vacancies for others to move from emergency into transitional accommodation where they can be given the skills to enable them to move on to long term independent living. Under the call for proposals in 2014, the Good Shepherd Services were approved for funding to upgrade and refurbish Edel House and Cork Simon Community were approved funding for the provision of a further 12 units of accommodation.

Under the devolved funding protocol for the allocation of Section 10 funding for homelessness, a budget of €4,272,197.00 was allocated for the South West Region with €3,480,298.00 for Cork City Council. Each Local Authority in the Region provided from their own resources a minimum of 10% of the overall allocation towards homeless services.

Housing Construction

In 2014, Cork City Council received a Capital Allocation of €1.793m for Housing Construction, from the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government. This allocation is facilitating the completion of 3 No. infill Schemes providing 6 units of accommodation as well as funding the final accounts on schemes that were completed in The Meadows Knocknacullen, Tannery Gardens, Lovers Walk and Susie's Field, Glentrasna, The Glen. A further allocation at the end of 2014 was made of €1.537m to fund the acquisition of 8 unsold affordable units into social housing stock.

In 2013 d'iarr an RCPRÁ sonraí faoi thionscadail tithíochta a d'fhéadfaí a chur chun cinn faoi Phacáiste Spreagtha Bonneagair lena ndíreofaí ar thógáil tithe sóisialta a mbeadh torthaí dearfacha orthu ó thaobh aghaidh a thabhairt ar an riachtanas tithíochta, gníomhaíocht gheilleagrach a spreagadh agus tacú le poist in earnáil na foirgníochta. I mí an Mhárta 2014, ceadaíodh i bprionsabal dhá thionscadal foirgníochta ar Shráid Ghearailt Uí Ghríofa agus ar Shráid Sheáin Philpott Curran Street atá le cur chun cinn sa tréimhse 2014/2015.

In 2013 the DECLG sought details of housing projects which could be progressed under an Infrastructure Stimulus Package targeting social housing constructions that would yield positive outcomes in terms of addressing housing need and in generating economic activity and supporting jobs in construction. In March 2014 approval in principle was received for two construction projects at Gerald Griffin Street and John Philpott Curran Street which are to be progressed over 2014/2015 period.

Athnuachan – Ceantar Thiar Thuaidh na Cathrach

Áirítear le hAthnuachan Thiar Thuaidh na Cathrach sraith tograí d'fhonn tithíocht ar ardchaighdeán agus meascán tionóntachta feabhsaithe a sholáthar, timpeallacht thógtha ar ardchaighdeán, bonneagar sóisialta níos fearr agus feabhas ar chúinsí eacnamaíocha an limistéir agus na n-áitritheoirí. Tá an chéad chéim tógála tithe ar bun agus tugadh faoi thionscadail shóisialta, tionscadail gheilleagracha agus tionscadail chomhshaoil éagsúil agus/nó cuireadh cúnamh deontais ar fáil ina leith.

Regeneration - City Northwest Quarter

The Northwest Regeneration includes a suite of projects to provide high quality housing and improved tenure mix, high quality built environment, improved social infrastructure and improvement in the economic circumstances of the area and its residents. The first phase of housing construction is underway and several social, economical and environmental projects were undertaken and/or grant aided.

Uasghrádú Creatlaí chun Feabhas a chur ar Éifeachtúlacht Fuinnimh

In 2014, fuair an Chomhairle Cathrach cistiú €2.4m ón Roinn Comhshaoil, Oidhreacht agus Rialtais Áitiúil chun bearta éifeachtúlachta fuinnimh a iarfheistiú in 1209 n-áit chónaithe. Áirítear leis na bearta sin insliú áiléir, insliú cuasbhalla pumpáilte agus fuinneoga na bhfoirgneamh a dhéanamh díonmhar ar shéideáin. Beifear ag leanúint ar aghaidh leis an tionscadal in 2015, tráth a bhfuil sé beartaithe insliú a dhéanamh ar 6,200 áit chónaithe eile, lena gcuirfear deireadh leis an ngné seo den tionscadal uasghrádaithe creatlaí.

Faoin Scéim um Thithe níos Teo de chuid SEAI agus faoin Scéim um Phobail Fuinnimh Níos Fearr, rinneadh iarfheistiú cuimsitheach i leith bearta fuinnimh ar 36 árasán ar chostas iomlán €640K. Rinne an Chomhairle Cathrach, SEAI agus Bord Gáis Energy comhchistiú ar an tionscadal. Tapófar deiseanna le haghaidh comhoibriú den sórt sin arís eile in 2015 ach fáil a bheith orthu.

Ag Cur Áitribh Fholmha in Úsáid Arís

In 2015, chuir an Chomhairle 261 áitreabh a bhíodh folamh ar ais in úsáid arís ar chostas €6m, agus fuair sí €2.6m den tsuim sin ar ais ón RCPRÁ. Má bhíonn cistiú ar fáil arís ón Roinn in 2015, tá sé beartaithe an líon céanna áitreabh a chur ar ais in úsáid.

Fabric Upgrade to Improve Energy Efficiency

In 2014 the City Council received €2.4m in funding from the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government for the retrofitting of energy efficiency measures to 1209 dwellings. These measures include attic insulation, pumped cavity wall insulation and the draught proofing of windows. The project will continue into 2015 when it is planned to insulate a further 6,200 properties thus bringing this element of the fabric upgrade project to an end.

Under the SEAI Warmer Homes Scheme and Better Energy Communities Scheme 36 apartments received deep energy retrofit measures at a total cost of €640K. The project was jointly funded by the City Council, SEAI and Bord Gais Energy. Should opportunities present for similar collaborative opportunities in 2015, they will be availed of.

Bringing Vacant Properties Back Into Use

In 2015 the Council brought 261 vacant properties back into productive use at a cost of €6m of which €2.6m was recouped from the DECLG. Should funding be made available from the department in 2015 it is planned to bring a similar number of properties back into productive use.

Ní hamháin gur clúdaíodh fóin phóca san athbhreithniú sin, ach clúdaíodh táibléid, mearóga USB agus gléasanna a bhfuil inrochtaineacht gan sreang, amhail logálaithe sonraí agus stáisiúin chianmhonatóireachta. Cuimsíodh san athbhreithniú úsáid na ngléasanna sin, na costais a bhaineann leo, na struchtúir rialachais atá i bhfeidhm agus na beartais agus na nósanna imeachta atá i bhfeidhm faoi láthair. I ndiaidh an athbhreithnithe sin, ullmhaíodh doiciméad nua um Beartas Gléasanna Móibíleacha, inar tugadh aghaidh ar roinnt laigí a sainaithníodh le linn an athbhreithnithe.

Uasghrádú ar an mBonneagar Fíorúil

Tacaíonn an Fhoireann Bonneagair TFC agus Seirbhísí Gnó le breis is 40 suíomh agus breis is 800 ríomhaire deisce trí theicneolaíochtaí éagsúla amhail inrochtaineacht gan sreang agus snáithín. Bhí na sócmhainní stórála agus na freastalaithe ag deireadh a saoil, agus dá mba rud é go gcoinneofaí iad gan iad a uasghrádú, bheadh riosca slándála agus sláine i gceist i leith shonraí agus oibríochtaí na heagraíochta. Agus aird á tabhairt ar thionscnamh néalchatalóige an OGCIÓ a bhfuil gné IaaS (Infrastructure as a Service) ceaptha a bheith san áireamh ann, d'fhorbair an fhoireann bonneagair straitéis chun teacht ar réiteach i gcomhair na heagraíochta lena ndéanfaí maolú ar na rioscaí a sainaithníodh agus íoslaghdú ar na costais arna dtabhú.

Is éard a bhí i gceist leis sin uasghrádú a dhéanamh ar an mbonneagar fíorúil atá ann cheana lena n-áirítear freastalaithe agus monatóir meaisín fhíorúil, freastalaithe fisiceacha eile a athrú ina gcinn fhíorúla, stóráil fhorlíontach ar chostas íseal a shuiteáil agus forbairt a dhéanamh ar straitéis nua um chur i gcúltaca agus athshlánú lena n-áirítear idir dioscaí. Ar an gcaoi sin, bhí ar chumas na rannóige TFC agus Straitéise Gnó an SAN (líonra limistéar stórála) atá aici a choinneáil ar feadh tamall eile go dtí go mbeidh an néalchatalóg bunaithe.

Excellence in IT systems

Cork City Council's ICT & BS Department was awarded the "Excellence in IT systems by a Local Authority" from the Public Sector Magazine. This reflected the development of our 22 websites, public facing services and new services such as our online public representation system.

Mobile Device Review

During the first quarter of 2014 the BPI Unit undertook a review of "Mobile Devices" in Cork City Council. This review covered not only mobile phones but also tablets, USB dongles and Wireless enabled devices such as data loggers and remote monitoring stations. The review encompassed the use of these devices, the associated costs, the governance structures in place and the existing policies and procedures. Following this review a new "Mobile Device Policy" document was drawn up which addressed some weaknesses identified during the review.

Virtual Infrastructure Upgrade

The ICT and Business Services Infrastructure Team supports over 40 locations and over 800 desktops using a variety of technologies such as wireless and fibre. The storage and server assets were end of life and would, if retained without upgrading, present a security and integrity risk to the organisation's data and operations. Taking account of the OGCIÓ's cloud catalogue initiative which is scheduled to include an IaaS (Infrastructure as a Service) element the infrastructure team developed a strategy to deliver a solution to the organisation to mitigate the identified risks while minimising the costs incurred.

This involved upgrading the existing virtual infrastructure including servers and hypervisor, converting additional physical servers to virtual, installing supplementary low-cost storage and developing a new back-up and recovery strategy including disk to disk. This enabled the ICT and BS department retain its existing SAN (storage area network) for an additional period until the cloud catalogue is established.

The award was presented by Mairéad McGuinness, MEP to Cork City Council's Health and Safety Officer, Paula Kennedy.

Following on from the increased commitment to safety by management and employees, the Local Authority Award is testament of the investment and resources that Cork City Council continually commit to the safety and health of employees. The Award recognises the Council's safety management system combined with strong management leadership and the goal to achieve continuous improvement. Compiling a submission to the awards places the Council's Health and Safety Management System under the scrutiny of an independent body and in turn Cork City Council gained an external review of the efforts invested into improving the Health and Safety culture and performance.

This improvement is a shared improvement between management and employees, both indoor and outdoor employees and Cork City Council would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge the personal commitment being made by employees in our journey towards continually improving the standard of health and safety.

The All Ireland Safety Awards are jointly organised by the National Irish Safety Organisation (NISO) and the Northern Ireland Safety Group (NISG) resulting in an average entry level of 1500 submissions by organisations in Ireland, Northern Ireland and the UK, across sectors such as energy, construction, manufacturing and transport.

City Centre Developments

The Cork City Centre Strategy was finalised in 2014 following its preparation by Colliers International on behalf of Cork City Council. It aims to revitalise the City Centre as the 'healthy heart' of the region.

A fund of €250,000 was specifically allocated in the Revenue Budget to implement the recommendations of the City Centre Strategy. This supplements funding which is already in place under other programmes e.g. the Economic Development Fund.

The following initiatives commenced in 2014:

- Architectural Conservation Area Grant Scheme: €45,000 was allocated for upgrading buildings in selected Architectural Conservation Areas in the City Centre.
- Painting Grant Scheme: Nearly 50 buildings were painted along the historic spine from Barrack Street to Blackpool and a number of other city centre streets.
- Area based funding from the City Centre Fund: Oliver Plunkett Street Quarter was targeted under a pilot area based scheme via a range of measures including building repair and painting grants and support for the Traders Group to examine branding and marketing of the area.
- South Mall revitalisation – a study commenced to examine how older properties on the street can be upgraded and used for a variety of purposes.
- Public Area Enhancement Scheme – a number of projects were carried out under this Government funded scheme including Cork Corners (painting of focal buildings), Tourism 'postcards' in vacant shop windows, small public realm upgrades, and an art project on the 'Singer' building on Washington Street.
- Derelict Sites – an updated survey of city centre derelict sites was undertaken.
- National Monument Grand Parade was refurbished.
- 'Tech Hubs' – a project to develop co-working office space for new and expanding companies in Parnell Place and Oliver Plunkett Street was commenced.
- Synthetic biology laboratory Grattan Street – Cork City Council provided a building and part funding towards setting up this facility which is a joint project between UCC and Tyndall National Institute.
- Trustee Savings Bank – was acquired as a strategic acquisition and proposals for its use are being considered.

- Saotharlann bitheolaíochta sintéisí ar Shráid Grattan – chuir Comhairle Cathrach Chorcaí foirgneamh agus páirtchistiú ar fáil i dtreo bhunú na saoráide seo, atá ina comhthionscadal idir UCC agus Institiúid Náisiúnta Tyndall.

- City Centre Movement Strategy – aims to improve access to and around the city centre by public transport, walking and cycling.
- Event Centre – the preferred bidder was selected and public funding of €20 million secured.
- City Centre office/retail developments – a major office development commenced at Albert Quay.



Barrack Street Renewal Project Phase 2 from the junction of Reid's Square to the junction with Noonan Road reached substantial completion in Oct 2014 at a cost of €940,000. The scheme creates a one way inbound traffic lane with widened footpaths and enhanced public realm consisting of new pavements, public lighting undergrounding of service cables, soft landscaping etc.

Kent Station

Work on the Kent Station to City Centre Linkage Project Phase 1 commenced in September 2014 and is scheduled to be complete in March 2015. The overall project (Phase 1 and Phase 2) is estimated to cost €3.5 million when complete. The scheme provides enhanced carriageways, pavements, bus lanes and cycle lanes between the station and the city centre.

Rinne an scéim athnuachan ar Shráid Washington, Bóthar an Iarthair, an Phríomhshráid Theas, Cé Proby, Cé an Fhrinsigh, Cé Pope agus an Meal Thuaidh.

Críochnaíodh an tionscadal seo in 2014, ar chostas iomlán €33 mhilliún. Faoin tionscadal, cuirtear débhealach saorshreafa ar fáil idir Tollán Sheáin Uí Loingsigh agus an N22, siar ó Bhaile an Chollaigh.

Tógadh agus osclaíodh sé cinn déag de stáisiúin i mí na Nollag 2014, osclófar cúig cinn déag eile de stáisiúin i mí Feabhra 2015.

Staidéar um Dhorchla Straitéiseach an Oirdheiscirt
Cuireadh an Staidéar i gcrích i mí Dheireadh Fómhair 2014. Rinneadh sainaithint sa staidéar ar aon cheann déag de thionscadail bhonneagair bóithre idir Dúglas/Machain agus Lár na Cathrach agus moladh infheistíocht a dhéanamh iontu.

Rinneadh athdhromchlú ar aon cheann déag de shráideanna/bóithre mar chuid den Chlár um Athdhromchlú Bóthair 2014. Cuireadh an obair i gcrích i mí an Mheithimh 2015 ar chostas €370,000.

UCC to City Centre Cycle Project

This project reached substantial completion in August 2014 at a cost of €2.56 million. The project provided new carriageways, footways, traffic signal systems, CCTV cameras in addition to the continuous cycle lanes and bus lanes between UCC and the City Centre. The scheme renewed Washington Street, Western Road, South Main Street, Proby's Quay, French's Quay, Pope's Quay and North Mall.

N40 South Ring Road, Sarsfield Road to Bandon Road, Flyover Project

This project was complete in 2014 at an overall cost of €33 million. The project provides a free flow dual carriageway between the Jack Lynch Tunnel and the N22 west of Ballincollig.

Cork City Public Bike Scheme

Sixteen stations were constructed and opened for use in December 2014. A further fifteen stations will be opened in February 2015.

South East Strategic Corridor Study

The Study was completed in October 2014. The study identified and recommended investment in eleven roads infrastructure projects between Douglas/Mahon and the City Centre.

Eleven streets/roads were resurfaced as part of the 2014 Road Resurfacing Programme. The work was complete in June 2015 at a cost of €370,000.

Asset Management & Maintenance Division

Jack Lynch Tunnel Upgrade

The Jack Lynch Tunnel Upgrade works to comply with the European Directive 2004/54/EC entitled Minimum Safety Requirements for Tunnels in the Trans European Road Network Regulations continued in 2014 with the installation of Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system and the barriers at either end of tunnel.

The cost of the upgrade works referred to amount to €7.5m and the National Roads Authority funded same. The main upgrade works are now completed. The operation and maintenance of the Jack Lynch Tunnel is being privatised and the successful tenderer (Egis Road and Tunnel Operation Ireland Ltd) commenced the preoperational period of 4 months on the 20th October 2014.



Plant & Machinery Section

The Plant & Machinery Department is a Section within the Roads & Transportation Directorate. The Section is a support service to Cork City Council. It provides a wide range of mechanical and electrical services to the directorates and other service providers. The section's objective is to provide these services to the highest technical standards in a cost efficient and effective manner.

Fleet Management Service (FMS)

The FMS has concluded the rollout of a new fleet supply arrangement for the provision of fleet plant for the City Council on a hire/maintain basis. The Plant fleet comprises of 230 items of equipment.

Déanann an tAonad Seirbhísí Foirgníochta maoirseacht ar sholáthar, ar shuiteáil agus ar chothabháil na ngléasraí go léir i bhfoirgnimh phoiblí, linn snámha, oifigí agus iostaí na Comhairle. Áirítear ar an ngléasra a ndéantar a chothabháil trealamh Soláthair Leictreachais, soilsiú, téamh, brath ionróirí, brath dóiteáin agus deataigh, agus trealamh CCTV. Le linn Nollaig na bliana 2014 bhí an tAonad Seirbhísí Foirgníochta páirteach i suiteáil soilse nua i bPáirc an Easpaig Lucy, mar aon leis na crainn Nollag ar fad de chuid na Comhairle Cathrach. Uasghrádú leanúnach ar na soilse Nollag feadh Shráid Phádraig agus Shráid Tuckey.

Building Services Unit

The Building Services Unit is responsible for the supply, installation and maintenance of all plant in the Council's public buildings, swimming pool, offices and depots. The plant maintained includes electrical supply equipment, lighting, heating, intruder detection, fire and smoke detection and CCTV equipment. During Christmas 2014, the BSU was involved in the installation of new lighting in Bishop Lucy Park and all the City Council Christmas trees, and continued upgrading of Christmas lighting throughout Saint Patrick Street and Tuckey Street.

Droichead Meáite Poiblí

Tá Droichead Meáite poiblí á oibriú ag an Rannóg um Ghléasra agus Innealra freisin. Tá an droichead sin ar Ché Uí Chinnéide laistigh de Phort Chorcaí agus soláthraíonn sé seirbhís an-tábhachtach, mar a cruthaíodh le déanaí nuair a bhí allmhairí salainn á mbailiú d'Údaráis Áitiúla ar fud na tíre. I rith 2014 suiteáladh deic choíncreite nua, in ionad na deice cruaithe cordaithe a bhí ann roimhe sin.

Public Weighbridge

A public weighbridge is also operated by the Plant and Machinery Section. This is located on Kennedy Quay within the Port of Cork and provides a very critical service as was proven recently during the collection of salt imports for Local Authorities through the country. During 2014 a new concrete deck was installed to replace the corded steel deck.

Other Services provided include:

The Plant and Machinery department participates in energy management projects in conjunction with the Energy Agency and other departments, to help reduce the council's energy demand and carbon footprint. Emoluments are also issued for the Plant and Machinery department.

Carrigrohane Bridge

Recent refurbishment of this bridge in 2014 and resurfacing of road at this bridge including new footpaths and drainage to alleviate flooding. Other works: repairs to Gaol Bridge and painting of pedestrian railings at pentode, Andersons, Union Quays and Trinity Bridge.

An Rannóg Iompair & Soghluaisteachta**Straitéis Ghluaiseachta Lár na Cathrach**

Glacadh Straitéis Ghluaiseachta Lár na Cathrach in 2012 agus tá sí le cur chun feidhme i roinnt céimeanna sna blianta atá le teacht. Faoin bplean, déanfar cothromaíocht idir riachtanais na modhanna iompair go léir i lár na cathrach agus beidh sé ina thoradh air gur fearr a mbeifear in ann brath ar amanna taistil ar iompar poiblí. Beidh timpeallacht fheabhsaithe ar fáil do choisithe agus do rothaithe de bharr na n-oibreacha. Rinneadh oibreacha ar na soilse tráchta agus an ductú i Sráid Washington, i mBóthar an Iarthair agus i gCé Pope roimh chur i bhfeidhm na straitéise.

Ceapadh comhairleoirí i mí Iúil 2014 le haghaidh an dearadh mionsonraithe a dhéanamh ar Chéim 1 agus Céim 2 den straitéis. Clúdaíonn Céim 1 Sráid Phádraig agus na taobhshráideanna máguaird agus clúdaíonn Céim 2 limistéar Phlás Grenville/Sráid Grattan. Cuirfear chun cinn an dá chéim chomh fada le cuid 8 in 2015.

Forbairt na Samhla Iompair Réigiúnaigh

Is é cuspóir na Samhla Iompair Réigiúnaigh cumhdach na samhla iompair atá i bPlean Straitéiseach Cheantar Chorcaí a leathnú ionas go mbeidh Cathair Chorcaí, Contae Chorcaí agus Ciarraí ar fad i gceist léi.

Transport & Mobility Division**City Centre Movement Strategy**

City Centre Movement strategy was adopted in 2012 and it is to be implemented in a number of phases over the coming years. The plan will balance the needs of all transport modes in the city centre and result in improved reliability on public transport journey times. The works will provide an enhanced environment for pedestrians and cyclists. Works were carried out on the traffic signals and ducting in Washington Street, Western Road and Pope's Quay in advance of the implementation of the strategy.

Consultants were appointed in July 2014 for the detailed design of Phase 1 and 2 of the strategy. Phase 1 covers St Patrick's street and the surrounding side streets and Phase 2 covers the Grenville Place /Grattan street area. Both phases will be advanced through part 8 in 2015.

Development of Regional Transport Model

The objective of the Regional Transport Model is to extend coverage of the CASP transport model to include all of Cork City, Cork County and Kerry.

Nuair a bheidh an tsamhail críochnaithe, beidh uirlis mheasúnaithe iompair cothrom le dáta, a bheidh den chéad scoth, ar fáil do Réigiún an Iardheiscirt, a mbeidh inniúlachtaí den scoth aici maidir le hiompar poiblí, samhaltú éilimh agus measúnú mórbhealaí.

Tionscadal Athraithe Iompraíochta – Pleananna Taistil chuig an Scoil agus an Ionad Oibre

Féachtar leis an tionscadal seo chun tabhairt faoi aistriú córa iompair, le himeacht ama, go dtí taisteal níos inbhuanaithe (siúl, rothaíocht, club roinnte carranna agus iompar poiblí) ar an turas chun na scoile agus go dtí an t-ionad oibre.

Scóip: Dul i mbun rannpháirtíochta le scoileanna agus le hionaid oibre chun feachtas a mhúscailt i leith modhanna taistil inbhuanaithe, agus iad a chur chun cinn.

Cuspóir: Aistriú córa iompair go dtí modhanna taistil níos inbhuanaithe a spreagadh i gcomhréir le beartais um Thaisteal Níos Cliste

Buntáistí Ionchais: Laghdú ar an mbrú tráchta ag scoileanna agus ionaid oibre, laghdú ar astaíochtaí, méadú ar thaisteal gníomhach, lucht oibre agus mic léinn níos sláintiúla.

Tugadh faoi roinnt beart sna scoileanna sa chéad leath den bhliain, lena n-áirítear clár oideachais agus feachtas, comhairle agus cúnamh maidir le pleananna taistil scoile, an rothaíocht chun na scoile a chur chun cinn, ranganna cothabhála rothar, oiliúint rothaíochta, páirceáil rothar, cur chun cinn an tsiúil, Park and Stride, iompar poiblí agus comhroinnt carranna i measc na mac léinn agus na foirne – is maith an sampla é ár gcuid rannpháirtíochta le Scoileanna Phádraig.

Tá comhlánú á dhéanamh ar na clár oideachais le feabhsúcháin bheaga ar bhonneagar, agus iad seo a leanas go háirithe:

Development of the model continued throughout 2014 and is due for completion mid 2015. Tasks undertaken in 2014 included the completion of the Zone system development and Road network development and Data collation phases, and work commenced on the trip end modelling, Public transport modelling and the Base year matrix model.

The new regional model will be consistent in approach methodology and software platforms as the other regional models being developed. The completed model will result in the obtaining of up-to-date state-of-the-art transportation assessment tool for the south West Region which will have superior public transport, demand modelling and highway assessment capabilities.

Behavioural Change Project – Schools and Workplace Travel Plans

This project seeks to bring about, over time, a modal shift to more sustainable travel (walking, cycling, car sharing and public transport) on the journey to school and to the workplace.

Scope: Engaging with schools and workplaces to raise awareness of and promote sustainable travel modes.

Purpose: Encourage modal shift to more sustainable travel modes in line with Smarter Travel policies.

Expected Benefits: Reduction of traffic congestion at schools and workplaces, reduction of emissions, increase in active travel, healthier workforce and students.

In schools a number of measures were undertaken in the first half of the year, including education and awareness programmes, advice and assistance on school travel plans, promotion of cycle to school, bike maintenance classes, cycle training, bike parking, promotion of walking, Park and Stride, public transport and car pooling among students and staff - our engagement with St Patricks Schools complex is a good example.

Small infrastructural improvements complement the educational programmes - some highlights include:

The Annual Financial Statement 2014, was prepared on an accrual accounting basis and included a full Balance Sheet showing assets owned and liabilities owed by the Council and was completed within the statutory time period.

The accounts are audited by the Local Government Auditor who reports to the Minister for the Environment Community and Local Government in Statement of Comprehensive Income (Income & Expenditure Account Statement) and Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet) for 2014 are included in this Annual Report

Annual Budget

The Annual Budget for 2015 was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Local Government Act, 2001 as amended by the Local Government Reform Act 2014 and the Local Government (Financial and Audit Procedures) regulations 2014. It was adopted by the Council on 24th November 2014.

Tá an muirear bunaithe ar fhéin-nochtadh agus tá dualgas ar úinéirí na maoine í a chlárú agus an muirear a íoc. Tá foráil sa reachtaíocht freisin maidir le forchur pionós um íocaíocht dhéanach a ndéantar a charnadh ar bhonn míosúil nuair a bhíonn muirear thar téarma. Bailíodh €2.06m in 2014 maidir leis an Muirear NPPR. Cuimsíodh sa tsuim sin pionóis agus muirir i leith 2013 agus na mblianta roimhe sin.

Bhí feidhm ag an muirear NPPR i gcomhair na mblianta 2009 go 2013. Local Property Tax

The Members of Council set the Local Adjustment Factor in respect of the Local Property Tax at -10% for 2015 at statutory meeting held on 29th September 2014.

Rates

Rates are payable on commercial and industrial properties. Following consideration of the Budget each year, the elected Members determine the Annual Rate on Valuation (ARV) to be levied for the following year. The ARV for 2014 was €74.05.

Non Principal Private Residence Charge (NPPR)

The Local Government (Charges) Act 2009 introduced a €200 annual charge which applied to Non-Principal Private Residences. The €200 charge is payable to the local authority in whose area the Non-Principal Private Residence is located. The charge is based on self disclosure and owners are obliged to register the property and pay the charge. The legislation also provides for the imposition of late payment penalties which accumulate monthly once a charge is overdue. The amount collected in 2014 in respect of the NPPR Charge was €2.06m. This was made up of penalties and charges for 2013 and prior years.

The NPPR charge was effective for the years 2009 to 2013. Part 12 of the Local Government Reform Act 2014 provided for the repeal of the legislation governing the Non Principal Private Residence (NPPR) charge following the introduction of the Local Property Tax and deals with the collection of undischarged liabilities relating to the NPPR charge.

Quarterly Reports

Under the EU/IMF Programme of Support for Ireland additional reporting requirements were introduced which require that quarterly data is provided to the

Department of Environment, Community & Local Government by all local authorities within 60 days of the quarter end.

The reports required are:

- Revenue Report - gives details of the revenue account expenditure and income for the year to each quarter end against the year's budget.
- Capital Report which gives details of the capital account opening balances, expenditure and income and closing balances for the year to each quarter end.
- Debtors Report - gives details of movements for each category of debtor for the year to each quarter end.
- Loan Report - gives a detailed forecast of interest and principal repayments on all existing and approved borrowings.
- Payroll/Superannuation Report - gives details of payroll and pension related payments for the specified period.

These reports were all submitted to the Department within the specified timeframes for the 4 quarters of 2014.

Publication of Purchase Orders over €20,000.

Under the Public Service Reform Plan, purchase orders procuring goods or services with a value in excess of €20,000 must be published online at the end of each quarter. These reports were published and are available for viewing on the Council's website as prescribed.

Payment of Accounts

Since 2011 all public bodies are required to report on their performance in relation to payment of invoices in the following categories:

- within 15 days of receipt;
- within 16 to 30 days of receipt; and
- in excess of 30 days of receipt.

These reports were submitted to DECLG within the specified timeframes for the 4 quarters of 2014 and are available for viewing on the Council's website.

Tuairisceán chuig na Coimisinéirí Ioncaim i leith Íocaíochtaí

Ceanglaíonn na Coimisinéirí Ioncaim go gcuirfeadh Comhlachtaí Poiblí, lena n-áirítear Údaráis Áitiúla, tuairisceán bliantúil faoina mbráid faoi Alt 891(b) den Acht Comhdhlúite Cánach 1997. Soláthraítear sa tuairisceán mionsonraí na n-íocaíochtaí le soláthraithe i gcás ina sáraíonn an t-iomlán bliantúil €1,000. Déantar íocaíochtaí atá faoi réir CCI (Cáin Chonarthaí Iomchuí) nó ÍMAT agus roinnt catagóirí eile a eisiáimh. Cuireadh an tuairisceán bliantúil isteach chuig na Coimisinéirí Ioncaim in 2014 laistigh den fhráma ama atá sonraithe.

Bainistíocht Airgeadais

Is stuama agus is críochnúil í an bhainistíocht airgeadais sa Chomhairle. Iniúchadh Inmheánach

Is é príomhról an Iniúchta Inmheánaigh dearbhú a sholáthar don Phríomhfheidhmeannach, don lucht Ardbhainistíochta, don Chomhairle thofa agus don Choiste Iniúcháireachta gur sainaithníodh na rioscaí éagsúla atá le sárú ag an gComhairle agus go bhfuil rialuithe inmheánacha cuí i bhfeidhm chun na rioscaí sin a bhainistiú. Déanann an fheidhm Iniúcháireachta Inmheánaí meastóireacht agus tuairisciú ar chórais rialaithe inmheánaigh na Comhairle agus déanann sí moltaí maidir le feabhsúchán nuair is gá.

An Coiste Iniúcháireachta

Tugadh isteach ceangaltais reachtaíochta athbhreithnithe faoi Acht um Athchóiriú an Rialtais Áitiúil 2014. Bunaíodh Coiste Iniúcháireachta nua tar éis an toghcháin áitiúil, ar a bhfuil ceathrar comhaltaí seachtracha agus triúr comhaltaí tofa. Comhaltaí Seachtracha: Aidan Horan (Cathaoirleach), Sean Angland, Gillian Keating, Margaret Lane. Comhaltaí Tofa: An Clr John Buttmer, an Clr Chris O'Leary, an Clr Seán Martin. Tháinig an Coiste le chéile cúig huaire in 2014 agus chuir sí tuarascálacha eatramhacha agus tuarascálacha bliantúla faoi bhráid na Comhairle.

Revenue Commissioner Report on Payments

The Revenue Commissioners require an annual report under Section 891(b) of the Tax Consolidation Act 1997 to be submitted by Public Bodies, including Local Authorities. The report provides details of payments to suppliers where the annual total exceeds €1,000. Payments subject to RCT (Relevant Contracts Tax) or PAYE and some other categories are excluded. This annual return was submitted to the Revenue Commissioners within the specified timeframe in 2014

Financial Management

Financial management reporting in the Council is robust and thorough. A rigorous system of monthly financial monitoring ensures that any significant budget variances are identified at an early stage and appropriate actions are taken to minimise any possible adverse financial impacts. These controls include regular financial reviews, monthly and quarterly financial reports which indicate financial performance measured against budgets on both expenditure and income and variance analysis evaluation and a midyear review.

Internal Audit

The primary role of Internal Audit is to provide assurance to the Chief Executive, Senior Management, the elected Council and the Audit Committee that the various risks facing the Council have been identified and appropriate internal controls are in place to manage those risks. Internal Audit evaluates and reports on the Council's internal control systems and makes recommendations for improvement where necessary.

Audit Committee

Revised legislative requirements were introduced by the Local Government Reform Act 2014. A new Audit Committee was established following the local election with four external and three elected members. External Members: Aidan Horan (Chairperson), Sean Angland, Gillian Keating, Margaret Lane. Elected members: Cllr John Buttmer, Cllr Chris O'Leary, Cllr Seán Martin. The Committee met on five occasions in 2014 and submitted interim and annual reports to Council.

Árachais

Déanann an Rannóg Airgeadais bainistiú ar phunann árachais na Comhairle. Maidir le Dliteanas Poiblí agus Dliteanas Fostóra, iompraíonn an Chomhairle barrachas nach beag maidir le gach uile theagmhas, rud a fhágann gur féin-árachaithe atá sí i ndáiríre i leith na ndliteanas sin, cé go bhfuil an clúdach tubaiste i bhfeidhm do theagmhais a d'fhéadfadh a bheith mór. Déanann an t-aonad árachais/éileamh den Rannóg Airgeadais bainistiú ar an bpunann árachais agus bainistíonn sé na héilimh aonair.

Insurances

The Finance Department manages the insurance portfolio of the Council. In respect of Public Liability and Employers Liability the Council carries a significant excess for each and every incident making it effectively self insured for these liabilities albeit that disaster cover is in place for potentially significant incidents. The insurance/claims unit of the Finance Department oversees the insurance portfolio and manages the individual claims.
